

# Rules for participating in ABC – general:

- Participation is effective from 1 June 2024 to 30 June 2024
- The following rules must be met for the ride to be valid maximums: max. speed 60 km/h; average speed 30 km/h; max. length of one trip ≤ 150 km
- All types of bikes are allowed (regular, mountain, racing, e-bikes, etc.)
- You can ride anywhere you want it is not necessary to ride only in ČB
- Participants can form teams the minimum number of riders in a team is 5, the maximum number is 25 (each rider can join only one team)

# How to join?

The process of joining the challenge is very easy. All you need is a smartphone and a bike of any type.

- Download the free Naviki app from Google Play or the App Store
- On the main page, tap on 'More' and then 'Login'
- Create an account if you don't already have one enter your name and your UNIVERSITY E-MAIL!
  - Please follow the rule of entering university emails for better identification of riders. You can change the email address you have already registered in Naviki (note that you must confirm the change by clicking on the link that will arrive at the newly entered email address)
- Select 'More' in the main menu, click on 'Competitions' 'ABC 2024' and activate the option 'I am participating'
- You will then be able to select the University of South Bohemia as the institution you will be riding for and answer a simple screening question
- You must also select the University department or academic area under which you belong

Only in the case of **graduates** who are unable to enter their university email, it is possible to use a personal email, but on the condition that they are either registered in the USB Alumni Club and enter the same email they used to join the club or they can easily register – USB Alumni Club registration.





### **Riding in teams**

This year we would like the teams to be as balanced as possible and therefore we ask you to fill the teams with as many members as possible (maximum 25 riders). Teams can be made up of riders from different departments, areas, types of study, parts of USB or faculties. Please challenge your colleagues and friends and join forces together for a good cause.

To join an existing team or create a new one, open 'Competitions', select 'ABC 2024 – University of South Bohemia', click 'Select Team' and select an existing team. Or tap on 'Create a team' and enter the name of the new team.

! TEAM NAME! must be entered in such a way that it best represents the faculty, rectorate, department, unit, group, etc. – first the abbreviation indicating the given part must be given, then you can add the name freely to distinguish the teams – for example, by number, nickname, designation 'students', etc.

Note: even student teams must first be identified using the faculty abbreviation!

Only the captain can confirm team members – to confirm a new team member, select your team, an orange icon will appear next to the new team member, click on it and confirm.

#### How to record a ride?

- To record a trip, tap RECORD TRIP on the Naviki home screen or tap the play button in the top right corner
- To save the journey, just tap the pause button and then the stop button. While you are using Naviki to navigate your planned route, the recording is automatic. You can save such trips as described above. Naviki considers all recorded trips to be part of the competition.
- Recording your rides and viewing offline maps does not require an internet connection. You only need to connect to upload the recorded trip to the global platform (and to the mileage totals for USB). This process will then take place

It is also recommended to take a print screen of the screen if you can.

Jerseys can be obtained by individuals and team riders and will be available for pick up at the Marketing Office (K3 first floor) from Mgr. Diana Kocábková.
